This is a resolution of the Jacksonville Downtown Investment Authority adopting FY 2018/2019 proposed budgets. This is your Southside TID, your Northwest TID, and your Downtown East TID for fiscal year 2018 through 2019.

So, Mr. Chairman, if we could, what I'd like to do is start with the Southside TID, which is SF 182. That's always easy for me to walk through, and then I'll come back to the Northbank, if you don't mind. Okay?

THE CHAIRMAN: Okay.

MR. WALLACE: Welcome, Ms. Durden. How are you?

So, Mr. Chairman, your ever-long taxes projected for fiscal year '18/'19 will be

\$4.041 million. With regards to expenditures, you see we set aside \$5,000 in Professional Services.

This will take care of -- for audit purposes.

THE CHAIRMAN: Thank you. It's approved.

The first action item on the agenda is Resolution 2018-06-01, our Tax Increment

itself, it's 3.026 million in expenditures.

2 And that's the Peninsula REV Grant, 625,000;

3 Strand REV Grant, 425,000. We've got the

4 Sunguard Rev Grant at 8,000; One Call

5 Commercial Revitalization Program grant at

6 100,000. We'll be putting a line item in for

7 the Southbank Riverwalk wayfaring signage.

8 We've got waterfront activation here, roughly

9 at about 18,000. We're setting aside

10 \$1.75 million for public infrastructure

11 improvements at the JEA site on the Southbank.

12 We've got interest on the Strand bonds of

13 178,000. And then we've got an interfund

14 transfer, so we're going to transfer out

\$404,000 to cover some of our administrative

costs. We're also replenishing funds into the

16

Downtown Economic -- to the Southbank Retail 17

18 Enhancement Fund of 178,000. Putting money

19 into Southbank parking, 250,000. So that gives

20 you the total expenditure of \$4.041 million.

21 That's your Southbank expenditure -- the 22 revenues and expenditures.

- the -- well, let's take the Northbank West. 4
- 5 There's a reason for it, because we moved
- 6 funding from -- I'm sorry, we take any excess
- 7 revenue from the west and we move that to the
- 8 actual east.

So Northwest TID projected revenues will 9

10 be \$5.148 million. Again, we set aside 5,000

for audit purposes. As we get into other 11

- 12 expenditures, expenditures total up to
- 3.237 million, and the breakout is the 13
- 14 following: We're budgeting for the MPS Urban
- 15 Core garage, which is the courthouse garage,
- expenditures of roughly 2.2 million. We've got 16
- the JTA/Fidelity parking lease at about 13,494. 17
- We have a REV Grant projected for Hallmark, 220 18
- 19 Riverside, 360,000. Pope & Land Rev Grant,
- 20 which is Brooklyn Riverside Apartments, at
- 21 325,000. We're looking to expand the REP
- program, and we're looking to put money into 22
- 23 that, and that would be \$338,513.

24 What we would also do is what we call an

25 "interfund transfer," which means that we will

be transferring money from the west to the east

- to cover expenses in the east, and the amount
- that we would transfer would be 1.906 is what 3
- we would transfer. And we have no cash 4
- 5 carryover. So, therefore, it would be -- total
- expenses will be 5.148 million, just as we have 6
- 7 in the revenues.

8 There's a scrivener's error on here that

- 9 says to Downtown East, 1,978-, strike that out.
- 10 And everything else will balance.

11 Do we have any questions on the west, sir?

- THE CHAIRMAN: Any questions? 12
- BOARD MEMBERS: (No response.) 13
- 14 THE CHAIRMAN: Seeing none --

MR. WALLACE: Moving on to the east, if we 15

- don't mind, ad valorem taxes is projected at 16
- 2.995 million. We've got debt repayment on 17
- 11E. That revenue will be coming in, so that 18
- would be 416,397. We get repayment from the 19
- Carling loan, 506,487. And you see you 20
- 21 transfer in the revenue from the west to the
- east, which is 1.906 million, and so that gives 22
- 23 you a total revenue on the Downtown East of
- 24 5.825 million.
- 25 As we run through expenditures, again, Diane M. Tropia, Inc., P.O. Box 2375, Jacksonville, FL 32203

- 5,000 set aside for audit purposes. You've got
- your expenditures at 2.9 million. That breaks
- down to the following: 800,000 goes to the
- self-insurance fund of the City. \$2 million to
- pay for MPS Arena and Sports Complex garages.
- \$5,000 for the Commercial Revitalization
- Program. We've got the Kraft Food REV Grant,
- 95,000. We've got to pay interest on the
- Carling bonds, 194,786. The principle on the 9
- 10 Carling bonds is 1.941 million. We've got to
- repay the loan that we took from the City last 11
- 12 year, which is 709,000. And the total debt
- there is 2.84 million. 13

14 We also have a \$75,000 payment. I think

- this is for -- for MOCA. We have no cash 15
- carryover. So your total expenditures would be 16
- 17 5.825. The expenditures line up with your
- 18 actual revenues.

19 Mr. Chairman, this is your TIF budgets for

- 20 next fiscal year as proposed today. There may
- 21 very well be some adjustments that we have to
- deal with come August, as we normally do, as we 22
- 23 get in better numbers over the summer, but
- 24 these are your projected ad valorem revenues as
- 25 of June 1st, 2018.
