I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>

Chair Ott called the meeting to order at **2:00 p.m.** Chair Ott then called for introductions from Board Members and Staff.

A. <u>AUGUST 14, 2025, DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT REVIEW BOARD (DDRB) REGULAR MEETING MINUTES APPROVAL</u>

Board Chair Ott called for a motion on the meeting minutes.

Motion: Member Brockelman moved to approve the meeting minutes.

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C. DDRB Application 2025-006 Moran Environmental (Conceptual Review)

Mr. Guy Parola presented an overview of 2025 006 Moran Environmental for Conceptual Review application. The applicant, Mr. Jason Gabriel, provided a presentation on the project.

Board member Loretta noted that the project plans require additional engineering detail prior to final approval. Board member Deiuliis commented that the project is a logical upgrade to existing structure and fits the industrial context of the area.

Chair Ott called for a motion on the item.

D. DDRB Application 2025-005 Pearl Square, N7 (Final Review)

Ms. Van Christiansen presented a summary of DDRB application 2025-005 Pearl Square N7 for Final Review Application. The applicant, Ms. Cyndy Trimmer, provided a presentation on the project.

Board member Jones raised coordination with the Florida Department of Transportation coordination for the state road facilities impacts on the project as a discussion item and inquired about the Beaver Street "road diet." Ms. Trimmer confirmed there is an ongoing working group on the issue with representation from the applicant team, DIA, and Public Works, and provided information on a forthcoming DIA mobility credit resolution. Board member Loretta requested clarity on elements of the pedestrian realm and landscaping; confirmed raised curbs around planters according to the North Core guidelines.

The general sentiment of Board Members included strong excitement about the Publix grocery anchor and design improvements. Mr. Delaney, Mayor's office, expressed full support, calling it an exciting project downtown.

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A deviation request was reviewed in a workshop meeting on October 9, 2025, prior to the DDRB regular meeting. As such, the Board was required to vote on this item prior to considering final approval:

Motion: Member Brockelman moved to approve the deviation request for 2025-005 with staff recommendations for 2025-005.

Seconded: Member Craig seconded the motion.
