B. CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS REPORT

The role of the Chief Executive Officer (the CEO) for the Jacksonville Downtown Investment Authority (DIA) is to lead, facilitate, inspire, plan and manage the programs and activities of the organization. The CEO reports to the Board of Directors of the DIA, providing the necessary financial and administrative reporting information and support to enable the Board to make responsible and prudent policy decisions. The CEO is responsible for the day-to-day management of the staff and budget of the DIA. John Pappas, Public Works Director and Keith Jackson with STV provided a presentation regarding the Hart Bridge Overpass Ramps Project.

B. NORTH FLORIDA TPO

Jeff Sheffield, North Florida TPO Executive Director provided a presentation tied to the Hart Bridge Overpass Project. The TPO would contribute funding or oversee federal funding to allow the project to take place.

Hart Bridge Overpass Ramps Project

Department of Public Works January 16, 2019





Removal of the section of elevated Hart Bridge Expressway through the Sports & Entertainment Complex and Downtown Redevelopment area (from Gator Bowl Blvd. to A. Philip Randolph Blvd.). This project provides improved access and connection to the area while also eliminating a visual barrier to the St. John's River.

Total Project Budget \$39 million...pursuing Design-Build Contractor





Scope:

- Demolish ¾ mile of elevated 4-Lane concrete Hart Bridge Expressway
- Construct a new ramp from the Hart Bridge down to Gator Bowl Blvd. (East end)
- Construct a New Ramp from Gator Bowl Blvd. at A. Philip Randolph Blvd. and connect to the elevated structure over Hogans Creek (West end)...continue access to/from Liberty Street via Forsyth Street/Adams Street/Duval Street





Scope:

- Construct a new ramp from the Hart Bridge down to Gator Bowl Blvd. (East end)
- Construct a new at-grade intersection (with Signal) at Gator Bowl Blvd. and the new Hart Bridge Ramp







Scope (cont.):

Construct 4-Lane Section with traffic separator/median and a 12' Shared (Bike-Ped) Path along south-side







Scope (cont.):

Construct a New Ramp from Gator Bowl Blvd. at A. Philip Randolph Blvd. and connect to the elevated structure over Hogans Creek...continue access to/from Liberty Street via Forsyth Street/Adams Street/Duval Street

Construct Bike-Pedestrian Paths that connect downtown area & Hogan's Creek

- Project is Funded thru a Partnership with Local, State & Federal Funding Sources...a Total Budget of 39 million
 - I. Local (COJ) thru Legislative Allocations \$14 million
 - a) \$1.5 million for initial Design Criteria Package Preparation
 - b) \$12.5 million for project
 - II. State (FDOT) \$12.5 million
 - III. Federal (FHWA) thru the Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development "BUILD" Grant - \$12.5 million



Current Status

- Finalizing Design Criteria Package development to allow for Design-Build Contractor selection
 - Finalizing detailed Design Criteria Package (DCP)
 - Performing some permitting (FDOT & Environmental) to ensure clear guidance for Design-Build Contractor
- □ Significant coordination with State FDOT
- □ Facilitating execution of the Federal BUILD Grant

- Advertise for selection of Design-Build Contract...issue DCP Part I (Qualifications Scoring) in 1st Quarter of '19
- Receive and Score Part I Proposals (Design-Build Team Qualifications Based Scoring) by 2nd Quarter '19
- Provide DCP Part II to short-listed Design-Build Teams (based on highest Part 1 scores) in 2nd Quarter '19
- Facilitate Alternate Technical Concept Discussions with short-listed Design-Build Teams and Finalize any & all Design Exceptions (modifications) by mid 3rd Quarter '19
- □ Receive Part II Proposals (with Price) by end of 3rd Quarter '19
- □ Score and Award to "Best Value" proposer...Lowest Adjusted Price

Execute Design-Build Contract by end of 4th Quarter '19

□ Initiate Design & Construction in 1st Quarter '20

- Plan is to initiate improvements at Eastern end of Project to facilitate Ramp Connection as quickly as possible
