

- Eligible Uses: Full-service restaurants, casual dining, bars/lounges, taprooms, coffee shops, bakeries, entertainment venues
- Structure: Zero-interest forgivable loan, forgiven over a 5-year compliance period
- Goal: Create a walkable, lively dining and nightlife destination in the heart of Downtown

SIGNAGE & BRANDING OPPORTUNITIES


- Street-facing storefront signage permitted along Hogan and Adams Streets
- Potential for awning/canopy signage and sidewalk café seating (subject to City approvals)

ABOUT THE BUILDING

The Ed Ball Building (214 North Hogan Street) is an 11-story Downtown landmark constructed in 1961 as the headquarters for Florida National Bank. Today, the City-owned building houses municipal offices and offers prime ground-floor retail opportunities that align with Jacksonville's Downtown revitalization.
